You are invited to a subsequent public hearing to discuss the I-95 Overland Bridge Replacement project. The project begins 2300 feet south of San Diego Road and ends at the St. Johns River.

The purpose of the proposed project is to replace the Overland Bridge, which carries both northbound and southbound traffic on I-95 and spans Hendricks Avenue, Kings Avenue, and Montana Avenue in downtown Jacksonville. The bridge is being replaced due to structural deterioration which is causing the need for frequent repairs. A previous public hearing was held on this project in January 2011. A Design/Build team has now been awarded the project. They have proposed minor adjustments to the highway geometry and maintenance of traffic during construction. The Department would like to receive your input on these modifications.

As of October 9, 2012, project materials will be available for your review during normal

business hours at the San Marco Library, 1513 LaSalle Street, Jacksonville, FL 32207 and the FDOT Urban Office, 2198 Edison Avenue, Jacksonville, FL 32204. Those who wish to submit

written statements may do so at the hearing or mail them to the address below no later than November 9, 2012. All exhibits or statements postmarked on or before November 9, 2012, will become a part of the public hearing record.

This notice is being sent to all property owners within 300 feet of either side of the proposed alignment.
