

## Access closes permanently from Main Street bridge to Hendricks Avenue

Direct access from the Main Street bridge in downtown Jacksonville to Hendricks Avenue is scheduled to **permanently** close the night of February 3. Construction crews with the Overland Bridge project will repaint the roadway lines Monday night, weather pending.

The reason for this closure is to eliminate conflicts between traffic merging from Main Street and exiting at Hendricks Avenue that currently crosses traffic merging from the Acosta bridge onto I-95.

Future traffic from Main Street to Hendricks Avenue will use Prudential Drive and Riverplace Avenue to get to Hendricks Avenue as shown below.



## Possible routes from I-95 to Hendricks Avenue include:

- Exit at Emerson Street and travel directly east to Hendricks Avenue
- Exit at Atlantic Boulevard traveling east; U-turn at Kingman Avenue (adjacent to Bishop Kenny High School) and travel back west to Hendricks Avenue
- Exit at Philips Highway and U-turn at the first available median turn lane back to Atlantic Boulevard, then travel west on Atlantic Boulevard to Hendricks Avenue

Old traffic pattern being eliminated is shown below:
