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FDOT Traffic Advisory

I-95 Southbound Traffic Shift Planned at Philips Highway

Jacksonville – Traffic is scheduled to shift at 6 a.m. Saturday on southbound I-95 at the Philips Highway (U.S. 1) off-ramp as part of the Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) I-95 Overland Bridge Project.

The existing southbound I-95 off-ramp to Philips Highway is being relocated further north. Motorists planning to exit at Philips Highway will travel onto the southbound service road and merge into the far right lane. The left lane on the service road will still exit to Atlantic Boulevard. This new traffic pattern is expected to last four months.

The southbound I-95 exit to Emerson Street can be used as an alternate route to Philips Highway.
